

E) INFORMATIVE STATEMENT ON PROCESSING THE PERSONAL DATA OF SUPPLIERS

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF EUROPEAN REGULATION 679/2016

Dear Sir/Madam,

We need to process information concerning you, your personal data, for the preparation and performance of the supply contract to which you are a party, or act as the supplier's representative, or participate as a service provider; to this end, as required by the European regulation for the protection of personal data (European Regulation 679/2016), we provide you with the following information.

1. Controller

The Controller, or the party responsible for the decisions regarding the purposes, modalities and security of personal data, is Sintagma S.r.l., with registered office in 06132 San Martino in Campo (PG), Via Roberta, 1, VAT number 01701070540, in the person of the legal representative *pro tempore*.

2. Purposes and legal grounds for processing

The personal data that you will provide us and that will be collected during the supplying of the services provided for in the supply contract will be processed for the purposes and according to the legal grounds indicated below:

3. Recipients and categories of data processed

The personal data provided by you or acquired during the course of the service will be processed exclusively by personnel authorized for this purpose or by processors designated for this purpose.

In addition to the persons or bodies to whom the data must mandatorily be disclosed by law, your data may be disclosed exclusively to:

4. Transfer to third countries

Your personal data will be transferred outside the European Union only if the transfer of your data is necessary for the performance of a contract between the data subject and the controller or the implementation of pre-contractual measures taken at the data subject's request; the legal ground is Art. 49(1) point b, GDPR.

5. Period for which the personal data will be stored and criteria used

The personal data being processed are collected in documents the storage of which is established consistently with the purposes of the processing as summarized below.

Contract documentation	Ten years from the termination of the contract relationship except for legitimate causes for suspension.

Administrative, accounting, tax documentation	Ten years from the termination of the contract relationship except for legitimate causes for suspension.

6. Rights of the data subject

The Regulation recognizes the following rights that you may exercise in respect of and against each joint controller.

- Right of access: Art. 15 of the European Regulation allows you to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed
- Right to rectification: Art. 16 of the European Regulation allows you to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, the data subject has the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by means of providing a supplementary statement.
- Right to erasure: Art. 17 of the European Regulation allows you to obtain from the controller the erasure of personal data concerning you without undue delay if there is one of the grounds provided for by the Regulation.
- Right to restriction: Art. 18 of the European Regulation allows you to obtain from the controller restriction of processing where one of the cases provided for by the Regulation applies.
- Right to object: Art. 21 of the European Regulation allows you to object at any time, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning you which is based on point (e) or (f) of Article 6(1), including profiling based on those provisions.
- Right to data portability: Art. 20 of the European Regulation allows you to receive the personal data concerning you, which you have provided to a controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and you have the right to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided, according to the conditions foreseen by the Regulation.
- Right to withdraw consent: Art. 7 of the European Regulation allows you to withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
- Right to lodge a complaint: Art. 77 of the European Regulation gives you the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the Member State of your habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement, if you consider that the processing of personal data relating to you infringes this Regulation.
